## Subject: PA Governor Candidates Education Platforms

#### Context:

Education is a Public Policy Priority of the Pennsylvania branch of AAUW with the objective of supporting a quality system of public education. Education funding, quality, delivery and curriculum are specific topics of debate in our state. Understanding the positions of state candidates may help inform our communities.

**Summary** (sources are the candidates' websites):

Shapiro

- 1. Increase state funding of public education
- 2. Utilize the 2016 state formula to make *new* funding more equitable across districts.
- 3. Appoint two parents to the state Board of Education.

### Mastriano

- 1. Reduce per student state funding of public education from \$19,000 to about \$9,000.
- 2. Use the "delta" to fund "Education Opportunity Accounts" that parents can use to pay for private, charter, or home schools.
- 3. Expand existing programs that give tax breaks to companies that fund scholarships to private schools.
- 4. Eliminate property taxes, a key source of public school funding.
- 5. Immediate ban on Critical Race Theory and Gender Theory studies.
- 6. Review of district Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Plans
- 7. Implement a Universal Parents Rights statute
