

HARRIET JAROSH ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION GRANT

The Harriet Jarosh Environmental Education Grant was established in memory of Harriet Jarosh, a long-time member and leader of the West Chester-Chester County affiliate of AAUW. She was passionate about supporting and preserving the environment. Upon her death, her family made a contribution to the affiliate, and it was decided to utilize the funds to support environmental education projects. AAUW – West Chester-Chester County has received additional generous support from its members and the fund is now invested so that it can remain viable in perpetuity.

Each year, the AAUW West Chester-Chester County board of officers makes a determination as to which project(s) should be supported. Current grants range from \$250 - \$500 per year.

Requests for funds must meet the following requirements:

- Project must focus on efforts toward increasing awareness and understanding of current environmental issues.
- Project must be conducted in Chester County.
- Project must provide for maximum inclusivity and accessibility.
- Requested funds may not be used to pay salaries.
- Recognize the support of AAUW in project materials
